Flute! in Hawaii 2019 is a masterclass for performers interested in developing performance and repertoire skills. Participants will perform in daily sessions led by artists Mary Karen Clardy and Sabrina Saiki-Mita, with a focus on standard repertoire and chamber music. Concepts of breathing, embouchure, tone production, musical phrasing, articulation, vibrato, and technique are addressed in the masterclass.

Mary Karen Clardy

Mary Karen Clardy, Regents Professor of Flute at the University of North Texas, appears as soloist and chamber artist throughout the United States, Canada, Mexico, Britain, Europe, Asia, South America, with numerous performances for the National Flute Association and British Flute Society. Her recordings include **Sonatas and Sonatinas, after syrinx....**, with October Trio, and **The Solo Flute Past to Present** for the EPR label; a solo recital of American Music for the BBC's Radio 3; and orchestral recordings for Pro Arte, Dorian, and Klavier labels. Renowned as a teacher, she regularly presents master classes at home and abroad, and her students are consistent winners of international and national competitions, holding prestigious orchestral and faculty positions throughout the world. An established author, Ms. Clardy's award-winning publications are in multiple reprint.

Sabrina Saiki Mita

Sabrina saiki-mita teaches flute at the University of Hawai'i at Manoa and Punahou Music School. She has maintained a private flute studio since 1990 in Hawaii and has extensive experience with students from elementary through post-retirement. A regular clinician at middle school and high schools on O'ahu, she has adjudicated for festivals, auditions in Hawai'i and Texas, as well as Southwest Division Woodwind Competitions for MTNA. Sabrina plays flute and piccolo with The Royal Hawaiian Band.

Flute! in Hawaii 2019

Flutists study and perform standard repertoire and chamber music in daily sessions led by artists Mary Karen Clardy and Sabrina Saiki-Mita, with an open class atmosphere to encourage observation in class sessions. Flutists are coached in various performing genres including concert, competition, orchestral audition, and recording techniques, with a focus on development of musical phrasing and technical consistence in performance.

Practice

Classes include concepts of musical phrasing, vibrato, tone, technique, and articulation, with emphasis on practice methods. Various methods, including Mary Karen Clardy's **Flute Fundamentals I and II; Etude Books I and II; Classic Solos 1 and 2; Classic Duets 1 and 2;** and **Classic Études** are used throughout the class to address individual strengths and challenges.

Production

In the 21st century, flutists are required to submit recordings for auditions, competitions, etc., and digital recording technology allows the production of high-quality recordings. Basic recording techniques, microphone placement, planning of recording sessions, and other elements are included in the class, with individual coaching in how to produce a quality recording using the most effective techniques for the best recorded product.
