Flute! in Ft. Worth 2019 is a day camp for flutists who want to build tone, technique, and confidence in musical performance and auditions. Sessions include basics of embouchure, breathing, tone production, musical phrasing, articulation, vibrato, and technique. Artists Mary Karen Clardy and Jennifer Rodriguez teach the camp, with chamber music rehearsals included to build ensemble skills, try other members of the flute family (piccolo, alto flute and bass flute), and develop sight reading skill.

mary karen clardy

Mary Karen Clardy, Regents Professor of Flute at the University of North Texas, appears as soloist and chamber artist throughout the United States, Canada, Mexico, Britain, Europe, Asia, South America, with numerous performances for the National Flute Association and British Flute Society. Her recordings include **Sonatas and Sonatinas, after syrinx...**, with October Trio, and **The Solo Flute Past to Present**, for the EPR label; a solo recital of American Music for the BBC's Radio 3; and orchestral recordings for Pro Arte, Dorian, and Klavier labels. Renowned as a teacher, she regularly presents master classes at home and abroad, and her students are consistent winners of international and national competitions, holding prestigious orchestral and faculty positions throughout the world. An established author, Ms. Clardy's award-winning publications are in multiple reprint.

jennifer rodriguez

Jennifer Rodriguez holds the Third Flute/Piccolo position with the Richardson Symphony Orchestra. An active performer and collaborative artist, Dr. Rodriguez has held positions with the Universidad Autonoma de Ciudad Juarez Orquesta Sinfonica, the El Paso Symphony Orchestra, the El Paso Opera Orchestra, and the Las Cruces Symphony Orchestra at NMSU. She is heard as a featured soloist with the University of Texas at El Paso Wind Symphony.

Middle School flutists from beginner through intermediate level participate in classes to build tone, technique, and confidence for next year's auditions and competitions in a fun environment! Artists Mary Karen Clardy and Jennifer Rodriguez teach classes focused on developing confidence in performance through fundamentals of tone and technique. Flutists are coached both individually and in flute choir rehearsals to develop ensemble skills and have fun! The Camp concludes with a concert of music learned during the camp and a party for campers, family and friends.

practice

Classes include warm ups, tone and vibrato exercises, scales and arpeggios, articulation studies, sight reading and flute choir rehearsals, with particular emphasis on practice methods. Various books, including Mary Karen Clardy's **Flute Fundamentals I and II**; **Etude Books I and II**; **Classic Solos 1 and 2**; **Classic Duets 1 and 2**; and **Classic Études** are used throughout the class to address individual strengths and challenges.
